CAPT. C. C. HARVEY
1837 - 1862

Son of Lemuel Harvey 1798 - 1886. Veteran. Floated family down Tenn. River on flat boat and then on Ohio until they reached the Miss. River at Cairo, Ill. Took steamboat on Mo. R. to Weston. Came to DeKalb Co. in 1848 and lived east of Maysville. His brother John W. Harvey 1844 - 1964 and son of Lemuel Harvey, was killed while defending his country at Osage Bridge.

Burton Slates' grandfather, W. H. Young, was commander of Post in 1897. The Post was named for Capt. C. C. Harvey, who lost his life at Lexington, Missouri and at the time of this roster it was a large Post. It must be understood, however, that in the 32 years since the war ended in 1865, a number of veterans of the County had passed away, so their names are not on this roster; also, a number of veterans in the county probably belonged to Posts at other towns. There may be errors, in the interpretation of the handwriting, so if a name is not quite as you may know it to be, that's the reason.
